## **Section 0: introductions of this nation**

### **What is the State of 8chan?**

1. The country of 8chan is in the IP address of 8ch.net where it stands online,
2. The nation of 8chan are created by the user and board volunteer-owner community.
3. The state of 8chan is controlled by the Forever-King (spiritual leader) and Head Army General, HotWheels, and he gives the power to the government.

### **What unites our people**

1. It is anonymity-friendly (supports Tor) and archive-friendly (8archive.moe).
2. It has wide file upload variety (from jpg/png to webm/gif/mp4 to swf & pdf).
3. It has large upload capacity (maximum 5 files at a time 5MB total).
4. It has video embed option, oekaki (drawing) and wide variety of text options.
5. It has custom flags and banners for unique, tags and categories for sorting boards.
6. It has HTTPS and CAPTCHA security and CSS customizer.
7. It had donation allowance and Booru connection services.
8. It has no login, no Adverts, no PermaBan and no Banlists.
9. It will not be effected by a corrupt up-down-vote system.

    - b. Side European: Yugoslavic, Romanian, Visegrad, Nordic, Benelux
    - c. East Asian: Tibetan, Mandarin, SouthernChinese, Japanese and Korean
    - d. S.E. Asian and pacific: Myanmar, Thai, Mon-Khmer, Malay-Tagalog, Oceanic
    - e. Muslim world: Persian, Turkish, Kurdish, Hindi, Arabic and Afrikan
  6. The International Bill of Human Rights (IBHR) is the standard human rights document of the State of 8chan, which includes one declaration and two covenants from the UN:
    - a. The Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR),
    - b. The International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights (ICCPR) and
    - c. The International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights (ICESC).
  7. The Universal Declaration of the Rights of Peoples (UDRP) can be used as an alternate human rights documents instead of the International Bill of Human Rights, but it needs more research, examination and dicussion to be accepted by the State of 8chan.

## **Section 1: Legislative Parliament structures**

### **The purpose of the Parliament**

1. The Parliament is the best way for anons to express their opinions.
2. It is democracy in the great image-board setting, the best ranking system.
3. It is not being controlled by the up-vote down-vote system used by Voat and Reddit.
4. People can vote on what they want and if they succeed getting a majority, it will be done.

### **Aliases for Parliament**

1. The Parliament can be refered to as “Congress” as a slang.
2. Members of the Parliament can be refered to as “Congressman” as a slang.
3. Members of both chambers are called “(Parliament) Member”.
4. Members of a singular chamber are called “Chamberman”.
5. The first chamber of the Parliament (/sen/) is called “(8chan) Senate”.
6. Members of /sen/ are called “Senator”, or “/sen/ator”.
7. The second chamber of the Parliament (/rep/) is called “(8chan) House (of Representatives)”, or “(8chan) HoR”.
8. Members of /rep/ are called “Representative”, or “/rep/resentative”.

## Human Status

The People of Parliament has 9 different statuses;

1. **Owner and Volunteers** (a.k.a Managers)
  - a. They are NOT Members of Parliament but instead “Managers” of Parliament.
  - b. Owners can punish Volunteers for misbehaviors.
2. **Anonymous** (non-seated) (a.k.a strangers or non-members)
  - a. They are NOT Members of Parliament.
  - b. No name or tripcode is required to be Anonymous.
  - c. They can vote in elections using ID numbers.
  - d. They can express opinions on Tripfag threads.
  - e. They can neither vote on actions nor start thread without notifying Managers.
3. **Citizen Tripfag** (non-seated, election-free) (a.k.a. citizen or voter)
  - a. They are NOT Members of Parliament.
  - b. Simillar to Anonymous but need to enter name and tripcode.
  - c. They get to have private replies from senate if email or contact info is given.
4. **Observer Tripfag** (reporter, election-free) (a.k.a Observers)
  - a. They are NOT Members of Parliament but consultants.
  - b. Simillar to Anonymous but need to enter name and tripcode.
  - c. They get to have private replies from senate if email/contact info is given.
  - d. They cannot join the elections and can only start or reply threads.
  - e. They get to have public replies and private replies.
  - f. They have the special right to examine the current situation of The Parliament
5. **Candidate Tripfag** (non-seated, running for elections)(a.k.a free candidates)
  - a. They must enter their name and secure-tripcode, and have to be registered in (See Candidate Registration).
  - b. They are allowed to have public replies and private replies.
6. **Party Tripfag** (non-seated, partisan) (a.k.a. party member or party candidates)
  - a. They must, and have to be registered in the general election thread (See Candidate Registration).
  - b. They an express opinions, start actions and affect how his party is managed but still cannot vote on actions.
  - c. They get to have public replies and private replies.
7. **Independent Tripfag** (seated, partisan-free) (a.k.a. independent senators)
  - a. They must enter their name and secure-tripcode, and have to be registered in the general election thread (See Candidate Registration).
  - b. They can vote on and start actions and have a maximum seat allowance.
  - c. They get to have public replies and private replies.
8. **Member Tripfag** (seated, partisan) (a.k.a. party senators)
  - a. They must enter their name and secure-tripcode, and have to be registered in the general election thread (See Candidate Registration).

- b. They can vote on and start actions and affect his party. They get to have public replies and private replies.

#### **9. Dead/Banned/Silenced/Censored Tripfag**

- a. People who are punished by the court to be silenced for disrupting The Parliament, which includes ex-Managers and ex-Members.

#### **Management :**

1. Management of Parliament is done by Managers.
2. All crimes will be judged by the Court and the Managers can Veto their decisions.
3. Managers can punish people based on violation of global rules or Parliament laws.
4. Violation of global rules will result in a ban, and the contents will be deleted.

#### **Edits and typo correction**

1. Managers can only edit others post upon request (on the edit thread) of the poster by strikethrough old text and add new ones next to them.
2. Typo correction is excluded from this rule and can be directly edited out upon request (on the edit thread).
3. Managers breaking these rules will be punished.

#### **Titles for Members**

1. All Members are allowed to have titles, but the titles cannot give extra political power.
2. Citizens, Managers and Observers are forbidden to have titles.
3. Members who have titles can opt-out to remove their titles.

#### **IRC safety and regulations**

1. The IRC channel `#/sen/` and `#/rep/` are part of the Parliament, therefore the Constitution applies to these IRC channels.
2. At least four of the seven political sects shall each have a "Tribute" to keep a recorder bot within `#/sen/` and `#/rep/` to create logs, and that they shall keep the logs public in pastebins.
3. Managers must make sure that no Tributes or other Managers either:
  - a. locking IRC out of public access, or
  - b. highjacking, spamming or pranking on IRC, or
  - c. manipulating logs without reporting publically.
4. If Tributes and Managers are unable to keep recorder bots in order, then there shall be a channel-wide ban of all IRC bots.
5. No outsiders can keep bots, perform the 4-Ts or the 4-As within the IRC, or else they will be kicked, and multiple offences will result in a ban in both the board and the IRC.

#### **Singular Elections:**

1. Elections are to be handled by Managers.
2. Proof of votes from citizens are required for it to be counted, and it needed:
  - a. suitable proof of personal identification i.e. secure tripcode or ID number,
  - b. registering by typing "voting" in the corresponding voting thread.

3. They are done either once every week or once per fortnight .
4. Candidates has to register by entering their name and secure-tripcode in the election registration thread or else they cannot join the election.
5. Voters are allowed to vote for up to 5 Candidates on 1 ballot only.
6. If a party gets lower than 0.5% of the total votes, they don't get seats. (Election Threshold)
7. The minimum seat requirement are defined by either Hare or Droop
  - a. Hare quota= $\text{totalVotes}/\text{totalSeats}$
  - b. Droop quota= $\text{totalVotes}/(\text{totalSeats}+1)+1$
8. Voting procedures will go as follows (Single Transferable Voting or STV):
  - a. First, The valid votes come in from the ballot box,
  - b. Then we check if any candidates pass quota,
  - c. If there is, the candidate(s) get the seat and surplus votes are transferred,
  - d. Sirplus Transfer value=  $\text{surplusVotes}*\text{nextChoiceRatio}/\text{Quota}$ ,
  - e. If not, eliminate candidate with the least votes and move vote to next choice,
  - f. Votes that have all candidate choices eliminated is discarded
  - g. If all votes are less than quota, then the candidate with the most vote get the seat
  - h. Repeat step b to g until all seats are taken

#### **Party system:**

1. All Tripfags (except Observers) can create parties.
2. Parties can share their seats in whatever way they want
3. If your party is to be found too similar to other parties it will be removed or merged.
4. A party must have:
  - a. A name and/or an acronym (For text representation),
  - b. a flag and/or an ensign (For visual representation),
  - c. A declaration and/or a slogan (For public to view),
  - d. An anthem and/or a salute (For public to view), and
  - e. A leadership and/or vote harvesting structure (For public access).

#### **Coalition System:**

1. Parties and Independents can create Coalitions to form alliances.
2. Coalition can be created via alliance of at least two parties and/or Independent Members, but it cannot have exclusively independent members (see Independents club).
3. Need to be reported and checked by Managers before becomming official.

#### **Independents club System:**

1. Independents club is formed when alliance of Independents but no party member is united.
2. They may not be seen as a Party but an alliance.
3. They can get more than the seat limit while being Independent:
  - a. if they are able to get more than seat limit of everybody and
  - b. if they give each member more than or equal to the seat limit.

#### **Actions and law making**

1. All laws has to pass 2/3rd of the total votes and reach a quorum of 20±10% of total seats.

2. Any laws that do not reach a quorum or have 2/3rd of total votes will not be passed.
3. Quorum is a universal law (a minimum of valid votes must be reached to pass laws).
4. An action can either be:
  - a. action-set (you are allowed to vote on the laws individually) or
  - b. action-pack (all laws are in one singular bundle).
5. The way to vote is to type this in bold or redtext like this:
 

**[(party/Member), Y/N/A, (number of seats)]** (using bold) or  
**[(party/Member), Y/N/A, (number of seats)]** (using redtext)

where Y (or +) is yes, N (or -) is no and A (or 0) is abstain or neutral vote.  
 N (or X) can be used as notation for not-voting seats.

### **Actions for handicapped senators**

1. There is a fourth option in voting for the Handicapped only.
2. The voting option is called “unfitting” with the alphabet U representing the vote.
3. If at least 1/3rd of all votes are “unfitting” then the Handicapped get to donate his action to another Member who have not voted N in the original action to fix it in the condition that:
  - a. he can rewrite everything except it can't lost its original purpose.
  - b. that when the Member get the donated action, it does not count as part of his or the party's daily action quota
  - c. The original purpose should be pre-written by the handicapped,
  - d. if he is breaking this rule will be silenced for 2 days and the Handicapped gets to pass the “unfitting” action on to another senator to fix, (judged by court)

### **Election Cycles**

The voting cycle shall be divided in 2 7-day subcycles.

1. Day1: open polls for voting (only citizens who registered on the respective board get to vote for politicians who have registered on the respective boards).
2. Day2: votes are sended to /sen/ board Managers to count the valid votes and to let parties to distribute their seats.
3. In Day1-2 actions pass by having 2/3rd majority on the chamber that is not having an election.
4. Day3-7 is normal voting days, where actions has to pass either 1/2th votes on both chambers or 2/3rd on total votes, Quorum applies to each chamber separately.
5. Day7 is when parties can register to join an election and have campaigns or commercial advertisements on /sen/ and /rep/.
6. The voting system for electing /sen/s are with STV for 100 seats (may expand to 200 or 300 when there is a long term lack of HoR) while /rep/ are with “Electoral College” PR of :
  - a. “simple”= $\text{ceil}(\text{UIP of board state}/k)$ , where  $20 \leq k \leq 500$  and
  - b. “fair”= $\text{ceil}[\log(\text{UIP of board state})/\log(k)]$  where  $k = (\text{prime} < 10)$  or  $\text{sqrt}(\text{prime} < 10)$  or  $\text{phi}$  or  $1/\text{Mascheroni}$  or  $\text{phi}^2$  or  $e$  or  $\text{pi}$  or  $2\text{pi}$
7. board state is the top 60 or 100 english boards excluding /b/, P.O., and governmental boards, 300-600 seats total.
8. After voting is finished HotWheels will give a seal of approval on the voting result if he is not busy bacuse of uniting this fine nation and leading our citizens.

### **Major Thread categories:**

All thread must have category on either the subject field or redtext/bolded on first line.

1. [Management/Voting] board Managers to take care of voting and other problems.
2. [Debate] arguments and preparation period for action (No voting until it is declared Action)
3. [Action] voting to pass or not pass an action (The top action allowance is 7 per party totals, 2 per party members or independents and 4 per one-man parties daily).
4. [Court] call upon the court to judge people and to clear disputes.
5. [Party/Coalition/Independents-Club] communication threads between Members of the same group (One per party/coalition/independence-club for tripfags only)

### **Minor Thread Categories:**

1. [Meta] board function testing, casual conversations and political events less Meta the better).
2. [Resources/Data] links and data for political research (Concentrate same topic on one thread).
3. [Simulation/Mapping] Using board games and computer simulations to do hands on research, including Risk and Resistance and MMO/MOBA (One thread per event period).
4. [Political advice] asking about political theory and political position of politicians (Political questions shall be concentrated in one single thread only).
5. [Shitpost] politically unrelated threads (default thread category) where creating more than one and the threader will get banned or threads will be deleted (determined by Managers).

### **Definition of Tripping, Trolling, shiTposting and Tossing/shiTflinging/Triggering (the 4-Ts)**

1. Tripping: Using a tripcode to maintain identity without good reasons for such need
2. Trolling:
3. shiTposting: Derailing and spamming threads with unrelated or obvious content
4. Tossing/shiTflinging/Triggering:

### **Definition of flAiming, hArassing/Abusing, pAsta-spilling/copy-pAstaing and mAiling (the 4-As)**

1. flAiming: Engaging in an derailed argument where conflicts and war can escalate
2. hArassing/Abusing:
3. pAsta-spilling/copy-pAstaing: Putting out personal and social information of their own
4. mAiling: Sending large amounts of emails and publicly releasing email conversations

## **Section 2: Judiciary sector courts**

### **Under Court (Judges determining crimes and disputes)**

1. Leaders of top 5 ranking parties will have to agree to judge crimes and disputes within 8chan.co and can put people into:
  - a. jail (tripcode silencing), and/or
  - b. probation (calm down period), and/or
  - c. restraint order (not being allowed to do certain things), and/or
  - d. call for execution (tripcode autofail and dead identity, done by military).
2. And that board Managers can always veto their decisions.

### **Higher Court (If anyone does not accept the Court decision)**

1. A balanced group of 35 or 49 based on the seven political sects shall judge.

2. If each sect has a simple majority then the new verdict is accepted.
3. It is impossible to not accept Higher Court decision unless the crime or change is a hyper-cross-board or across 8chan and allied site.
4. The Head Army General can veto the decisions of the court at anytime.

### **8chan Supreme Court (Judging crimes and disputes beyond 8chan.co area)**

1. The 8chan supreme court is consist of:
  - a. political parties (~50 people) coordination team (balanced between party sects),
  - b. board owners and volunteers from the top 100 english boards excluding /b/, P.O. and governmental boards (~300 people), and
  - c. ally sites of 8chan with users of 8chan (<2000 people total).
2. It is used to judge everything that is beyond 8chan.co including foreign crimes and crimes that are on allied sites.
3. The Head Army General can veto the decisions of the court at anytime.

### **Human Status**

1. **Clerks** (The people who owns /court/)
  - a.
2. **Judges** (The people who determins legality)
  - a.
3. **Anonymous** (a.k.a strangers)
  - a. No name or tripcode is required to be Anonymous.
4. **Citizen Tripfag** (a.k.a. citizen)
  - a. Simillar to Anonymous but need to enter name and tripcode.
  - b. They get to have private replies from senate if email or contact info is given.
5. **Parliament Tripfag**
  - a. Name and Secure-Tripcode must be provided to be valid in court to claim yourself to be a Parliament Member or a Manager of Parliament.
  - b. Managers are allowed to register Secure-Tripcode by Messaging the Clerks.

### **IRC safety and regulations**

6. The IRC channel `#/court/` are part of the Court, therefore the Constitution applies to these IRC channels.
7. At least four of the seven political sects shall each have a "Tribute" to keep a recorder bot within `#/court/` to create logs, and that they shall keep the logs public in pastebins.
8. Managers must make sure that no Tributes or other Managers either:
  - a. locking IRC out of public access, or
  - b. highjacking, spamming or pranking on IRC, or
  - c. manipulating logs without reporting publically.
9. If Clerks and Judges are unable to keep recorder bots in order, then there shall be a channel-wide ban of all IRC bots.
10. No outsiders can keep bots, perform the 4-Ts or the 4-As within the IRC, or else they will be kicked, and multiple offences will result in a ban in both the board and the IRC.

### **List of Bad Behaviors**

1. Illegal content or violation of Global rules: Thread deleted, IP banned and report to P.O.
2. Organized Board Sliding: IP banned and “Board Restoration”
3. Cross-broad Thread-bots: Thread deleted and report to P.O.
4. Riots on Governmental boards: Determined by Court
5. Manager or Clerk abusing power: Determined by Court
6. 4-Ts or 4-As: Determined by Court

### **Criminal Color Code (Triangle code)**

1. White is for Juvenile delinquency and minor offences.
2. Green is for Professional Criminals, Convicts and Prison Bosses.
3. Blue is for Foreign Forced Laborer, Emigrants and Asylum seekers
4. Purple is for Religious Criminals, Secret Societies and Heretical Cultists.
5. Pink is for anti-GSRM extremists, sex offenders and zoophiles.
6. Brown is for Foreign racial warfare criminals.
7. Red is for Political Prisoners, Socialists and Nationalist.
8. Inverted and red is for:
  - a. Prisoners of war (W),
  - b. local spies and traitors (S), and
  - c. military deserters and criminals (M).
9. Black is for:
  - a. the mentally ill and antisocial (I),
  - b. drug sellers and overdose (O),
  - c. work avoiders (A),
  - d. vagrants and beggars (U),
  - e. anti-conscription pacifist (P), and
  - f. anarchists and libertarians (L).
10. Inverted Yellow and black-yellow is for Kikes.
11. Inverted black and yellow is for race defilers.

### **Punishment institution code**

1. E or EH represent education and reformatory inmates (intellectuals).
2. NN represent political activist and resistance helpers (code meaning “Nothing Infinite”).
3. BV represent limited preventive custody.
4. PH or PSV represent police secure custody (awaiting trial or tried but not yet executed)
5. SK represent private punishment institution.
6. GL represent labour force institutions.
7. KZ represent execution and capital punishment institution.
8. Red dot represent escapees. bar represent repeated crimes.
9. From top to bottom: ID number, Bar, Triangles, institution and red dot.

### **Rules for the prisoners:**

1. No private contractors shall be allowed to profit from prison labor of any sort.

2. All prison labor profits shall go towards funding the criminal justice system and any debts of the convict in question.
3. Prisons shall be inspected on a regular basis to ensure that all labor meets legal occupational safety and health standards.
4. Getting new tattoos (a prominent step towards gang membership) are already banned within prisons themselves, but the steps taken to remedy the situation so far have largely included segregating gang members from non gang members.
5. Each correctional facility have a dedicated tattoo removal program.
6. All tattoos on a prisoner shall be documented upon arrival such that any tattoos added while incarcerated shall be immediately removed along with any other form of body modification received, so long as removal is possible.
7. Gang members from the same gang outside of prison shall be segregated not only from non-gang members but also from other members of their same gang.
8. It is required that prisoners in solitary confinement be allowed at least one hour of socializing per day (ideally face-to-face communication with non-guards, but socialization could also mean approved phone calls or internet communication), noting that all socializing shall be done under surveillance for the duration of the hour.
9. Most makeshift weapons in prison are produced from objects provided by the prison such as razors and toothbrushes.
10. As an alternative to providing prisoners with razors and plastic toothbrushes, it is required that prisoners be actively shaved on a daily basis by a third party, allowing for facial hair and individual styles (to a point, noting that anything presenting a hazard or distraction will not be an option) while preventing prisoner access to razors.
11. Plastics pens will be replaced by “stabless pens”.
12. Plastic toothbrushes will be replaced with rubber ones.
13. Prisoners will be paid competitive wages relative to legal day laborers in similar fields, though their earnings will be distributed by the state itself..
14. Parolees can either be in a work program attempting to find them work in the private sector, or continue their manual labor as a government employee for a period of time not exceeding half of their parole.
15. Private entities are banned from profiting from prison labor.
16. All cleanup crews must be on public or government-owned land.
17. Any construction work will be for public transport and will be restricted to non-essential manual labor so as to avoid any possibility of sabotaging of public works.
18. During the hours in which convicts cleaning up or working, the area in question will be off limits to the general public for their safety and to avoid potential prison breaks.
19. All prisons to have soap on a rope and guards in the prison showers themselves.

## **Section 4: The Excecutive sector**

### **The Prime Minister voting committee**

1. The voting cycle is once per 3-4 7-day sub-cycles.
2.  $200 * n$  seats to elect the Prime Minister of 8chan ( $0 < n < 7$ ).
3. There are 50 seats each in the four voting blocs of the top 100 english 8chan boards excluding /b/ and P.O., which the bloc names are:
  - a. NSFW, Meme and "Special" boards,
  - b. Politics, Philosophy, STEM boards,
  - c. Media, Arts, Music and V/TG boards,
  - d. Interests and Lifestyle boards.
4. The Prime Minister election method:
  - a. All citizens get to vote their top seater of the board,
  - b. seater must be registered on the board that votes,
  - c. votes are summed in categories and divided by ratio,
  - d. to distribute the 50 seats into one of the voting blocs.
  - e. After all 200 seats are taken, voting for Prime Minister begins,
  - f. the seaters can only vote for candidates who registered on /sen/ or /rep/,
  - g. and the candidates who reaches FPTP wins the role for Prime Minister.

### **The job of the Prime Minister**

1. The Prime Minister will have a 28 day (short month or bi-fortnight) term.

2. The Prime Minister has a special right:
  - a. he gets to suggest 3 actions a day (not counted as party actions), and
  - b. his actions is passed when both chambers reach simple majority.
3. The Prime Minister can only be kicked out of office if either:
  - a. 3/4th of the senate or HoR agrees to it, or
  - b. the Managers kick him out of office.

## Section 5: Banking sector

### Monetary and Fiscal sector of 8chan

1. Chanmarks is the official unified currency of 8chan.
2. The currency is anchored to type-A and type-B precious metal surpluses.
3. All Chanmarks must be created by the Central Bank of 8chan.
4. The parliament has the job to set economic budget plans and control how public money is spent while setting taxes for the people.
5. The parliament will only accept resources as money and currencies created by parties, coalitions and top 100 non-english boards excluding /b/ and /meta/.
6. Free trade is allowed within the government and the board states.

### Names of currency

1. 1 mil is the lowest unit of chanmarks. 1 cent is equal to 10 mils,
2. 1 dime is equal to 10 cents, 1 dollar is equal to 10 dimes,
3. 1 eagle is 10 dollars and 1 union is equal to 10 eagles.
4. Prefixes can multiply the amount of chanmarks represented:
  - a. "Quarter-" is quarter of original amount,
  - b. "Half-" is half original amount,
  - c. "Two-" is double original amount,
  - d. "Three-" is triple original amount,
  - e. "Stellar-" is quadruple original amount

### Types of metal surpluses.

1. Type-A surplus are Coinage Metals, which includes gold (79), silver (47) and Copper (29).
2. Type-B surplus are Platinum group, where:
  - a. Type-B1 surplus are platinum (78) and palladium (46),
  - b. Type-B2 surplus are iridium (77), osmium (76), rhodium (45) and ruthenium (44).
3. Type-C includes Non-refractory early transitional metals (21-25,39-40,71-72).
4. Type-D includes Refractory metals (41-43,73-75).
5. Type-E includes Rare Earths.
6. Type-F includes Iron Group (26-28).
7. Type-G includes Zinc Group (30,48,80).
8. Type-H includes Radioactive metals.
9. Type-J includes Alkali metals and Alkali Earths.
10. Type-K includes Post-transition metals and Non-metal pure element surplus.

### Local Exchange Trading Systems (LETS) or Community Exchange Systems (CES) regulations

1. Cost of service is created from the community and used for the community

2. No compulsion to trade created by community members against other members.
3. Information and disclosure about balances of any member is available to all members.
4. Equivalence to chanmarks or other foreign currencies.
5. Interest free money lending and trades tax-free transactions.
6. A central organization system created by the community is enforced.
7. Small membership fees or “community taxation” to cover administration costs is allowed.
8. Members maintain clear directory of offers and wants to help facilitate trade.
9. Members may trade by “paying” each other with either:
  - a. printed notes while logging transaction, or
  - b. encrypted electronic credits that auto-logs transactions, or
  - c. cheques which are later cleared by the system accountant
10. Members whose balance exceed specified limits positive or negative are obligated to move their balance back towards zero by either earning or spending (trade stops is allowed)
11. These names are regulated under the names of LETS or CES:
  - a. “Mutual credits” (common currency defined by chanmarks),
  - b. “Time banks” (currency defined by work hours), and
  - c. “Exchange specific currencies” (currency defined by surpluses)

## Section 6: Intellegence sectors

### **The Great Roundtable or The Safety Council**

1. There shall be a semi-public Roundtable group consisting of global volunteers and representatives of the top 60 boards, and HotWheels himself, that will be activated in an emergency where 4chan attacks 8chan.
2. The board volunteers will coordinate how to seal off outsiders from attacks, for example, captcha codes, passwords, filters and IP checks.
3. Also, roundtable emergency news alerts shall be sent periodically to alert 8chan citizens of who is attacking and how it attacks.

### **Emergencies caused by 4chan**

1. In the case of 4chan attacking 8chan (emergencies), Mockingjays shall be chosen to help fight back against 4chan by gathering all people from other image boards and social media sites to all retaliate against 4chan.
2. There shall be multiple safety bunkers (hidden boards and IRC with encrypted data) within 8chan to protect itself from 4chan attacks and to alert 8chan citizens.
3. Also, people must set protective areas within GoogleDocs and other archive and document or information sharing websites to prevent shut downs by 4chan.

### **Security Drills and testing**

1. Security drills will be used every 42 days to test how well 8chan can dodge attacks, how secure the safety bunkers are, and how fast they can alert 8chan citizens. This includes:
  - a. penetration testing (DoS and DDoS durability),
  - b. counter-doxing (how well we can detect and delete dox), and
  - c. illegal content (CP, DMCA or harassment) spamming.

2. GNAA, LulzSec and JIDF are listed as “Terrorist Enemy Number One”...

### **Emergency Recruitment and Escorts**

1. In the case of 8chan having a war with 4chan, suitable 4channers and socialtards (social media users) volunteers shall be recruited as spies, scouts or strikers (front liners) to increase the number of armymen when in needed, and 8chan has to escort them by any means.
2. Non-dox background checks may be necessary in finding volunteers to escort, but social altruism and forgiveness is the best way to form alliances and gather volunteers to fight.

### **Secret Society Project**

There shall be a secret society within 8chan. And this will not be related to Legion in any way.

### **Operation Expand SkyNet and the great organizations**

1. These will have their own advocacy group:
  - a. Weapon and Firearms + Technology and Electronics
  - b. Secularism and Humanism + STEM and academia
  - c. Video Games + Tabletop Games
  - d. Music and Audio + Movie and Television
  - e. Comics and Manga + Cartoons and Anime
2. There are rules for these advocacy groups:
  - a. Anybody can be a producer
  - b. Everybody is a consumer
  - c. We will boycott if our demands are not met
  - d. We are a stronghold with money to lobby against opponents
  - e. We rally to show our numbers and our enthusiasm
  - f. Media can't attack us, Governments can't control us
  - g. United while independent

**Default classification using 20 sections of 5% each**

1. The higher class: one sector for capitalist class, two sectors for upper-middle class,
2. The middle class: seven sectors for lower-middle class, five sectors for working class,
3. The lower class: three sectors for working poor and two sectors underclass.

**Default classification using 6 equal sections of 16.66...% each**

1. one sector for Rich and upper-middle classes,
2. two sectors for middle (lower) class,
3. two sectors for working classes, and
4. one sector for lower class and underclass.

**Optional economic classification using other methods:**

1. Uberich, Rich, Upper class (together called the Wealthy classes),
2. Up-middle class, Middle class, Lo-middle class (together called Home Owner classes),
3. working-rich class, Working class, Working-poor (together called lower class), and
4. underclass/poor.

**Calculations on pareto curves**

1. To calculate the pareto equality curve we use  $e^{(1/H)} = (1+H)/(1-H) = ((1+H)/2)^a$ .
2. H is the pareto determinant constant and a is the pareto graph constant.
3. It also uses  $y = 1 - (1-x)^{1-a}$ .
4. x is the richest population by fraction (1 being all the people within the population)
5. y is how much money they own by fraction (1 being all the money in the population).

## **Time and date systems**

### **Time scales (to be debated)**

**The NEETS and NAEMS problem**

## **Worker Union Laws**

1. Every worker has the right to join or form a trade union. This right cannot be infringed by employers under any circumstance. Such infringements may include, but are not limited to, the following:
  - a. Terminating employment on the basis of unionisation
  - b. Reducing pay of unionised workers (On this basis)
  - c. Harassing or assaulting unionised workers (Or encouraging others to do so)
  - d. Bans on unions or union activity
2. Trade unions have the right to appoint 2 members to a company's board of directors and appoint a workplace safety commissioner. The role and function of a workplace safety commissioner is to:
  - a. Advise workers and employers on workplace safety issues
  - b. Report breaches of safety rules to unions and employers
  - c. On the failure of employers to commit to a safe workplace, be permitted to encourage industrial action.
3. Workers and trade unions have the right to use industrial action in order to win improved conditions or pay. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
  - a. Strike action, including general strikes, secondary strikes, wildcat strikes, sympathy strikes and workplace occupation.
  - b. Slowdowns or 'go-slows'.
  - c. Work-to-rule.
  - d. Picketing and protesting outside of a workplace to discourage (via peaceful, non-obstructive dialogue) workers from continuing work
4. Trade unions are able to use their collective power to negotiate pay and other conditions on behalf of individual workers, providing consent from the individual worker. Negotiations can be with one employer or industry wide (Pattern bargaining).
